

What is the course?

This NRA approved Rifle Training Course is aimed to provide a comprehensive introduction to full bore rifle shooting.

This is a "fast track" way of getting your Firearms Certificate. As you may already be aware, you cannot simply put in for an FAC.

At the end of the course, upon completion and (hopefully) passing, you will receive a letter of recommendation from us, to put in with your application form, to state the training you have undergone.

This course is suitable for complete beginners, that have never shot crifle, upwards, as it starts from the basics.

For the intensive course, you will be sent pre-learning material which should be read prior to the course starting. Although you will be taught the information during your days with us, there will be A LOT of information, so it would be of great benefit for you to read through the information sent to you.

When is the course?

The intensive course learning will be over 2 days. Please speak with a member of the Reception team for dates.

You are then required to do a minimum of 4 x practice sessions following the course.

You must remain as a probationary member for 3 months following your 2 days of learning. At the end of this 3-month period, providing all practices have been completed, you may then take out full membership and receive your completion paperwork to put in for your firearms application.

Start time for each day is 9:30am with an approx. finish time of 4pm.


The Modules

MODULE 1 Safety and Intro to Target Shooting, including Safe Handling and Range Safety Regulations; .22 Gallery Rifle shoot at 25 yds or 5.56/308 shoot at 100 yds.

MODULE 2 Marksmanship Principles; MOA, intro to sighting systems; basic firearm cleaning and maintenance; Full bore shoot at 100 yds.

MODULE 3 Full-bore shooting at 100 yds and zeroing to 300/600/1000 yds with Iron sight (TR and Historic) and scoped rifles (bolt action and straight pull); basic positional techniques.

MODULE 4 & 5 Target marking/butt duties; Range booking procedure. Gallery Rifle, revision and assessments for Shooter Certification Cards (SCCs). Competitive shooting events; specialist "Introduction To..." courses and Club/Association leads. Assessment for course completion.



Course Cost Summary

The cost for the intensive course is £599 per person. This payment is required upfront, when you sign up with us to participate in the intensive course.

You will then have practice fees & membership fees (see below) on top of this amount.

Additional fees to be aware of:

Practice



Whilst on the training course, you are required to do a minimum of 1 practice session for each module (Total of 4 practices, minimum).

The cost of practice sessions has been outlined on the "course cost summary" page, under the "additional fees to be aware of" section.

You must book in via our website, for your practice sessions.

Please ensure that you are with us a minimum of 15 mins ahead of your booking, to allow time to book in at reception and to collect your gun & equipment from the gun shop.

Membership & Course Completion

On completion of the training course, (at the end of the 3 month probationary period), you are required to take out Full membership of our Range, for us to issue your letter of recommendation, which will then allow you to put in for your FAC.

Your letter of recommendation is valid for 12 months. You may continue to be a Probationary Member with us for a period of 6 months from your course completion date (Mod 4/5), if you do not wish to do your membership straight away.

If you do not take out full membership, you will not receive your letter of recommendation. Without being a full member of the club, thus not receiving your letter of recommendation, you cannot apply for your FAC.

The annual membership fee allows you to use the range as often as you wish, with no lane fees.

Full membership is usually £300 per year and runs for a 12-month period from the date of joining. The Full membership is discounted for you to £250 for the first year, as you have undertaken the course.

A membership card shall be issued once you become a full member. You will need to provide us with one passport sized photo for your membership card (either a hard copy or via email).

What to do next?

If you want to join the training course, please fill in the "Prospective Member" application form and return it to us. You can find this on the next page down and either print the page and fill it in, or a PDF version can be found on our website. Please go to www.cambridgegunclub.co.uk/rifle-range/rifle-training-course/

Get the form back to us by: Attaching to an email / Taking a photo of your form and inserting the photo to an email / Drop the form off on site / Post it to us.

We will then discuss with you some dates which will work for you.

Again, this will be over 2 x days.

We will then require the full payment to confirm your booking.

Please note that we must send all applications for the course, through to Cambridgeshire Firearms Department, where they will run their required checks.

The Firearms Department will contact us if they reject an application. We shall notify you if this occurs, although the Firearms Department will not explain to us the reasons for rejection. Should you wish to query this, you would need to liaise directly with the Firearms Department. Although rejections are rare, your payment will be returned to you, if you are unable to participate in the course.
