Each session is 90 minutes and includes all equipment, gun usage, safety equipment, instruction, ammunition, range lane usage, targets etc are within the price. No extra fees. These sessions are 1–1 with the instructor.

Directions:

From Wilburton – As you turn onto the B1049 (Twenty Pence Road), travel 2.5 miles then turn left down Long Drove. We are the first property you reach. See images below.

From Cottenham – As you leave the village on the B1049 (Twenty Pence Road), when you reach the national speed limit sign, travel 1.8 miles then turn right down Long Drove. We are the first property you reach.
